The Patriot Hospice veteran program started in honor of Dan King Sr., of North Jackson, and his impressive military legacy. He served in the Army Air Corps. and was a World War II fighter pilot.

Dan survived his plane going down in Germany and being held at a prison camp. He and his wife, Shirley, were married for 75 years before she passed away in 2017. They raised seven children.

Besides being a mechanical engineer and U.S. Steel retiree, Dan spent more than four years with the 910th Carrier Squadron, was chief of the North Jackson Fire Department, a Boy Scout leader and helped start the North Jackson Credit Union.
